Amok Theatre was represented in INFANT 2009 by its founders, Ana Teixeira, director, and Stephane Brodt, actor. Besides presenting an exquisite performance introducing many new theatrical elements in the Balkan region, they both led a three day workshops based on the methods used by Etienne Decroux and Ariane Mnousckine.
